All About Me and My Family

Come learn about and share your family stories at Buffalo Niagara Heritage Village to earn your My Family Story Badge. Prior to your visit, conduct an oral interview with a family member and keep a journal for 4-6 weeks. Bring both with you and we will help you make your very own family tree and story. After a visit to our research library, where you will see how family stories are kept alive, we will all gather together to share our own family stories.

This program is open to all ages, but Brownies will earn their My Family Story Badge. This is a 2 hour program with a minimum of 10 girls. The price is \$10 per Girl Scout.
